

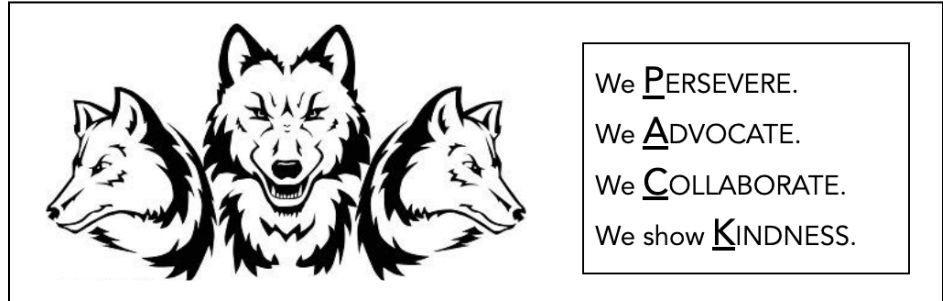
Dear Roger Clap Families & Community Members,
