**Choice 1:**

**Write a letter to John Lewis**

John Lewis died in 2020. **Write him a letter** sharing what you think he would want to know has happened since he died. *Your letter can include:*

- What has **changed** since this story took place; what has changed since he died
  - What has **not changed** since this story took place; what has *not* changed since he died
  - **Questions** you have about his experiences
  - **Advice** you need for dealing with issues of injustice you experience
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**Choice 2:**

**Record a Speech**

John Lewis began his activism giving speeches. **Record yourself giving a speech**, in the style of John Lewis, talking about an issue that is important to you. *Your speech can include:*

- A description of a **current issue** and your experiences with an **injustice**
  - A **plan** for change
  - A **reference to history** and this book to inspire others to work towards change
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**Choice 3:**

**Plan a protest**

John Lewis organized many people to join him in protesting injustice. Decide on an issue that you feel strongly about changing. **Make a plan for a protest** that will inspire others to notice and join you in making real change. *Your protest plan can include:*

- An **invitation** for where, what, when, and why you are protesting
- A **poster** to bring to the protest that outlines your goals
- A **list of actions** you will take to get others involved
