At this point students who receive this service are receiving about 1 hour/week of ABA. It is expected that this amount of ABA service delivery will increase as more staff are hired. Families were informed that they can request additional updates about their child's IEP services through the IEP process and by contacting the school (you don't have to wait for a meeting to get an update!) Families provided feedback about a new vision statement for our school that has been drafted by the Inclusion Planning Team (IPT).
