Criteria for logo:

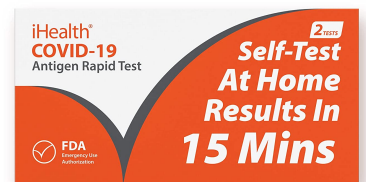
- Incorporates all 4 core values (perseverance, advocacy, collaboration, and kindness)

School Wide Updates:
