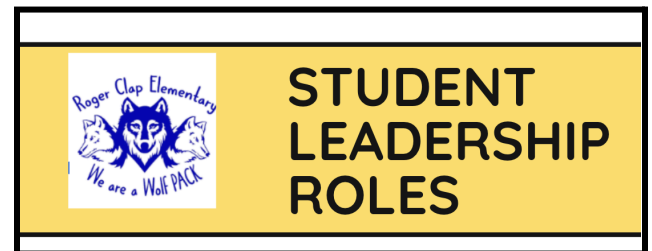




Dear Roger Clap Families,

This year the Roger Clap Culture & Climate Team have launched and supported a number of programs to help bring cross-grade level relationships, develop students' leadership skills, and support the shared responsibility of our "PACK" values! Please check out the initiatives below and encourage your learner to share what impact these activities have on their sense of belonging and sense of safety at the Roger Clap!

- **Clap Clubs:** To give students the chance to explore their interests, discover new talents, and connect with other students across grade levels who share their passions. Our hope is this fosters a sense of belonging that creates a feeling of safety within our school community. (Clap Clubs are returning on Wednesday, April 30 for round 2!) Some Clap Clubs include: Slime Club, Walking Club, Birding Club, Dance Club, & Drawing Club.
- **School Wide Jobs:** To give students an opportunity to take on real responsibilities and learn the value of teamwork, leadership, and make a positive impact on their community. Older students fill out an application, take on a leadership role and show responsibility for our communities' safety. Some student jobs include: Bus Captain, Science Helper, & Hallway Monitor, & ST Math Coach.
- **Book Buddies/PACK Pals:** To bring students from different grades together, building friendships and mentorships that create a supportive, connected school family.
- **Student-Led Town Hall:** To give students a voice. It's a chance to share ideas, celebrate successes, and work together to make our school even better by encouraging PACK values.
- **Weekly RJ Circles:** Create a safe space for students to share their thoughts and feelings, solve conflicts, and strengthen their relationships — building a culture of respect and understanding.
- **Dollar Dress-Up Days:** These fun, themed days bring us all together, build school spirit, and show that when we come together, amazing things happen.
