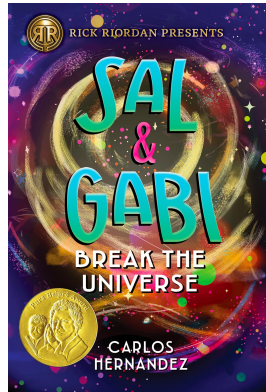


## 2023 Incoming 6th Grade Summer Reading Activity

As you read, think about the questions:

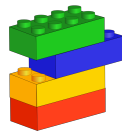
- **What is your current universe like? What do you like? What needs to change?**
